

# Nova Scotia Part-Time French Language Assistant Program

The Nova Scotia Part-Time French Language Assistant Program provides work experience to Nova Scotian students currently enrolled in postsecondary education. As part of the program, candidates will create and deliver activities in French for elementary or secondary students eight hours a week for a period of six months beginning October 1<sup>st</sup> and ending March 31<sup>st</sup>. French Language Assistants are paid \$5,333.00 (taxable) over a period of six months.

### Role

- Help classroom teachers by supporting and motivating students learning French and focusing on skills required for fluent speech.
- Organize cultural activities designed to help students discover and appreciate the French language and encourage them to continue learning and improving their skills.

Note: French Language Assistants do not replace teachers.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

To be eligible for the Nova Scotia Part-Time the French Language Assistant Program, candidates must be:

- Competent in French, both written and spoken.
- A citizen or permanent resident of Canada (individuals studying in Canada under a student visa are not eligible).
- Enrolled as a full-time student for the following September in a postsecondary institution in Nova Scotia:
  - Acadia University (Wolfville)
  - Atlantic School of Theology (Halifax)
  - Dalhousie University (all provincial campuses)
  - King's College University (Halifax)

## To submit an application

Your application must contain the following:

- The completed application form
- The following documents :
  - Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residency in Canada (birth certificate, passport, citizenship card, permanent residency card, etc.)
  - Your most recent transcript with issuing institution's seal
  - Your CV

\*Please note: Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Application deadline is **March 15<sup>th</sup>**. Otherwise, you will be placed on a waiting list.
