Abu Dhabi Grammar School Canada (AGS) is an international, Nova Scotian, Canadian School situated in the heart of the city in Abu Dhabi. Abu Dhabi is the Capital of the UAE <https://visitabudhabi.ae/en>. It is a modern, vibrant, city with Arabic as its first language; however English is spoken by most, It has been consistently voted as the safest city in the world for the last number of years.

AGS is a grade primary (KG1) to grade 12 school that teaches the Nova Scotia (NS) curriculum. Students graduate with the General Education Certificate of the U.A.E. and a NS diploma, which is accepted all around the world. Our students represent over 40 different nationalities who after graduation attend Universities in many different parts of the world. Most of our students are from expatriate families, however we do have some Emirati families studying for the NS diploma.

Our staff is a mixture of young, middle aged and retired teachers, Most of the staff are from Canada. We currently have a staff of 69 with 17 Arabic teachers who are required to teach the UAE Arabic and Islamic curriculum. It is UAE law that all students must study Arabic and the Islamic students study the Islamic religion.

Our pre-covid population was over 1100 students. Currently we continue to grow. We are being proactive and looking for teachers for the 2025-26 school year. To teach here you must have an undergrad degree and a Bachelor of Education and be eligible for a Nova Scotia Teaching Certificate.

Teachers benefits include: a reasonable salary based on experience and your educational background, a housing allowance (<https://www.oakshotels.com/en/oaks-liwa-executive-suite>), 1-return flight per year, visa and health insurance paid for and a 2 year contract with a short probation period.

We are looking for teachers who are beginning a career or nearing the end of a career, for elementary, junior and senior high positions.

At this point we are looking for teachers for September, 2025 in the following areas;

- Junior High- Math/ Science
- Grade 9, 10 Science
- High School English
- Guidance Counselor Kg1-12; experience in High School.
